**Welcome/Introductions:** Chair, Ms. Mockabee welcomed everyone and asked for introductions. Last month's meeting minutes were approved.

**EFSP Update**

Ms. Klinedinst reported no updates for this month.

**Subcommittee Reports**

**CoC Application:** No update.

**Review and Ranking:** No update.

**HMIS:** Ms. Mockabee reported that Ms. Blechertas has submitted the 2016 AHAR.

**10 Year Plan – Theme 3 Discussion and Updates:** Mr. Woods reviewed Theme 3 – Increase economic stability and there was discussion about stagnant action steps.

**Coordinated Assessment:**

Ms. Mockabee stated that there was a meeting for the review of individuals with Vi-SPDAT completed. There were seven people reviewed although there was no permanent supported housing available.

**Recuperative Care (Medical Respite)**

Ms. Newton stated that WellSpan had two providers for this transitional program. This will be a 30-45 day program of medical and case management through Bridges To Health. One provider will have three beds available for men and the other provider will provide 2 beds for women.

## **Veterans**

Ms. Mockabee reported that last year there was a push for Mayors to declare the end of Veterans homelessness. This year the push is to declare that if Veterans experience homelessness it will be brief and non-reoccurring. There is a discussion as to whether the County will be making this declaration anytime soon.

## **Sheltered Point-in-Time Survey**

Ms. Mockabee announced the PIT date as Wednesday, January 25, 2017 for the sheltered survey. All those staying in housing on the night of the 25<sup>th</sup> should be counted. Interview forms and bed surveys will be completed on paper only this year. Materials will come from Ms. Blechertas and a timely return of materials in early February is requested.

## **Unsheltered Point-in-Time Survey**

Ms. Mockabee announced that the service-based/street count will be conducted on Thursday, January 26, 2017 – asking the question of where you stayed the night of the 25<sup>th</sup>, to avoid duplication. Ms. Mockabee sent sign-up sheets around for all who wanted to participate in the count this year. Southern Communities will be doing counts in the Shrewsbury/Stewartstown area, New Hope Ministries will be doing the counts in the Dillsburg and Dover area and Changing Lives Shelter covers the Hanover Area.

## **Agency Announcements**

Ms. Klinedinst announced that Natalie Williams will be starting as the new Assistant Director of Community Impact with the United Way of York County.

Ms. Ish announced that she is with the PA Link to Aging & Disabilities. A Federal grant has been obtained to help with the Adams and York Counties aging and disabled population. There will be a hoarding training in March for York County Professionals. In October there will be the same training for family members.
