Ruth Robbins stated that CPC reapproved three more years of doing the Housing Council. Shelly Peterson and others have taken the Housing Council Exam and are now certified Housing Counselors.

Crystal Ouedraogo stated that Next Door is in transition due to turnover of Case Managers and the relocation of their bi-lingual counselor.
