

**YORK AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION
TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MEETING
2/1/18 MEETING SUMMARY**

1. Call to Order for the Technical Committee

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Mike Fleming at 9:00 a.m.

2. Introductions

Chairman Fleming began a self-introduction by members of the Technical Committee and meeting attendees.

4. Minutes of the November 2, 2017 Technical Committee Meeting

A motion to approve the Minutes of the November 2, 2017 Technical Committee Meeting was made by Ron Miller and seconded by Nate Walker. Motion carried.

6. Committee Reports

- a. 2019 Long Range Transportation Plan Committee – Mike Pritchard, YCPC
Mr. Pritchard stated that the Long Range Transportation Plan Committee met in December. There were five working groups established from that meeting. These groups will be meeting in February to start the planning process for the Long Range Transportation Plan. This plan has been branded as “Go York 2045” with a website of www.GoYork2045.com

7. Unfinished Business

- a. 2019 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Update – YCPC and PennDOT District 8-0

- i) Draft York Area Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
Mr. Walker reviewed the 2019 York TIP projects for York County

Mr. Walker reviewed the cost breakdowns for the various types of TIP projects for York County

Ms. Bitner explained that there was a RT 30 Safety study in Jackson and Paradise Townships. One location identified in the study was Big Mount-Labott Road. Several options have been identified; the more expensive option was a roundabout at a cost of \$2.4 million. This roundabout would help to provide clear site at the intersection and reduce the observed speed in the area currently measured at 52-58 miles per hour.

Mr. Clark stated that the list of local bridges has not been completed. There is a very short list and Ms. Bitner is working with the owners to select the best projects for the TIP.

- ii) Draft Interstate Management Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
Mr. Walker reviewed the 2019 York TIP projects for York County
- iii) Air Quality Significant Projects
Ms. Nidam reported that York is a maintenance area for the Air Quality Clean Air Act designation for the EPA. The Air Quality report is required for the long range plan and to conduct air quality conformity when we update the TIP. The draft TIP projects will be air quality significant projects.

A motion to approve these projects as air quality significant while meeting the Air Quality Conformity Analysis was made by Larry Smith and seconded by Felicia Dell. Motion carried.

- iv) PennDOT Connects Project Meeting Status
Mr. Clark stated that forms for the new projects that are to be added to the TIP were sent to the municipalities. If the forms are not returned by the municipalities by the deadline an effort will be made to reach out to them for those missing forms. The Central Office will have a PennDOT Connects outreach meeting on March 7th. This meeting will be an introduction to the HUB which is where municipalities come together and share ideas.

- a. 2017 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Actions – Adam Grimes, PennDOT

- i) Highway and Bridge Administration Modifications

- Mr. Grimes reviewed the 2017 TIP Modifications for the Highway and Bridge Administrative Modifications.

- b. Report on Congestion (ROC) -Beth Nidam, YCPC

- Ms. Nidam stated this report is generated every two years, and the last report was done in 2015 and reported on the 2014 information. This report will not show the large projects from last year, Longstown Road or the Adaptive signals on RT 30 and 74. From 2012 to 2016 there was a 4% growth in miles traveled on the roadways and the time traveled has had a 1% growth. This translates into more people, and more miles but the time traveled is staying close to the 2012 numbers.

9. Other Business

- a. Congestion Management Process (CMP) Signal Timing Project – Beth Nidam, YCPC
Ms. Nidam stated that there are 120 intersections that should be reviewed for signal timing. The major municipalities are on board with this process, but some of the smaller municipalities have not yet committed to the process. These signals should be retimed every three – five years to comply with the municipal signal permits.
