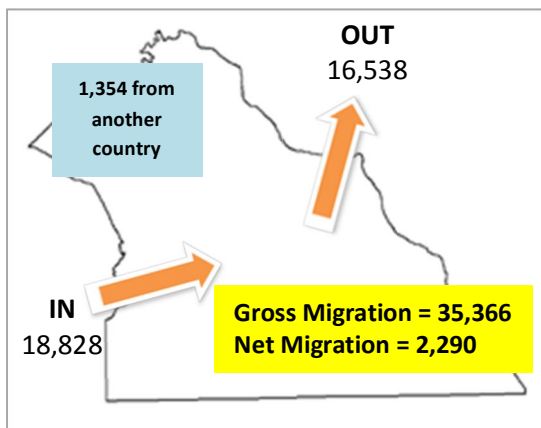
## County-to-County Migration Flows

In February, the United States Census Bureau released the 2007-2011 American Community Survey (ACS) County-to-County Migration Flows for PA. The data documents movement of the population between counties.

During this time, 243,379 persons moved into PA from another state. Additionally, 227,297 moved out of PA, leaving a net migration of 21,082 for 2007-2011. Data also shows that approximately 1.5 million people moved within the State of PA during that same timeframe.

## York County Migration, 2007-2011

In York County, 18,828 persons moved into the County (2007-2011) and 16,538 moved out of the County.

## Population Inflow

Of the 20,182 people who moved into York County, 8,259 moved from another County in PA. Table 1 shows the counties with **the highest number of movers into York County**.

## Population Outflow

During the same time period, 25,985 persons moved out of York County. Table 2 presents the **highest number of movers out of York County**.

The 2007-2011 (ACS) County-to-County Migration Files provide tables for every county in the US, showing both inflows and outflows. The ACS collects data regarding residence one year ago. That residency is used in conjunction with the location of the current residence to determine the residential mobility. The data does not capture more than one residential move in the five-year period.
