2014 State Population Estimates Released

On December 23, 2014, the US Census Bureau released the annual National and State Population Estimates. The population estimate for the State of Pennsylvania is **12,787,209**. Pennsylvania is the 6th most populous state behind California, Texas, Florida, New York and Illinois. Pennsylvania's total population has increased 0.7% since 2010. The 2010 population was 12,702,379.



Natural Causes

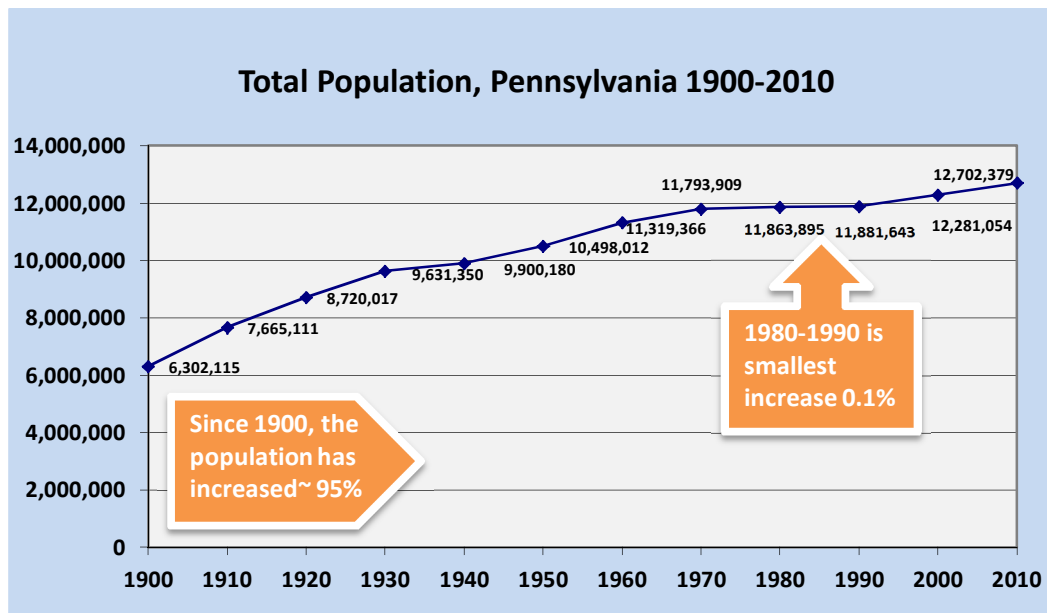
604,903 births

539,878 deaths

29,004 net migration

Factors that affect population change include natural causes (births and deaths) and migration. About ¾ of the total population increase 2010-2014 is accounted for by natural causes.

Migration data for the same period shows that Pennsylvania had a net migration 29,004 persons, which is the difference between those moving into PA and those moving out of PA.
