THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (LGAC)

Was created by the York County Board of Commissioners by resolution. It is a committee of elected and appointed municipal officials representing the townships and boroughs of York County. The LGAC currently provides a local government perspective on proposed projects, provides a network of information sharing for municipal officials on planning issues, and reviews planning projects and makes recommendations to the York County Planning Commission



HOW LGAC CAN BENEFIT YOUR COMMUNITY

- Sounding board for municipal issues;
- A forum to relay County initiatives back to local boards and councils;
- Ordinance language ideas; and
- Keeping apprised of proposed regional projects and potential legislation affecting municipal planning.

- Explore Restructuring—The YCPC and LGAC members continue to explore the restructuring of LGAC;
